BACKGROUND:

At the request of City Council President, the item of "City Council Committee Structure" has been placed on the agenda for City Council discussion.

FINDINGS AND ANALYSIS:

- The current City Council Committee Structure is as follows:
 - The City Council meets to take action the 1st and 3rd Mondays of each month and in special sessions as called by City Council or Mayor.
 - The City Council meets as the Committee of the Whole to discuss possible action items the 2nd and the 4th Monday of each month and in special sessions as called by City Council or Mayor.
 - There are two Stand-By Committees: Finance/Urban Development and Public Service Safety.
 - The Stand-by Committees meet as called by the Committee Chairs.
 - Items to be acted upon by the City Council are generally first placed on the agenda of the Committee of the Whole.
 - Items on the Committee of the Whole may be referred by the Stand-by Committees. However, agenda items may also be added by City Council referral, Mayor request and City Administrator request.
