

Separation Requirements

For proper recycling or disposal, your various waste types are handled as follows:

Recycled

- Cardboard, plastic, aluminum, tin, paper, glass, newsprint, magazines
- Tires, appliances, metals
- Annual Electronics Collection Event Saturday prior to Clean Up Week

Composted

- Yard Waste collected berm-side May - September.
- Yard Waste Sites open April 1st-Nov 15th.
- Loose leaves vacuumed berm-side in October

Diverted

- Inert Waste (Construction & Demolition debris, furniture, non-putrescible waste)

Prohibited

- Hazardous Waste — paint, used oil, antifreeze, etc. call for disposal instructions.

Baled/Landfilled

- Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) - putrescible (household biodegradable) waste

Curbside Recycling Program

- No separation required - simply commingle all recyclables
- Plastics #1-#7, Glass, Paper, Aluminum, Tin/Steel, Cardboard
- Place by 7:00 a.m. on designated recycling day - every other week
- Use city-issued containers or you may purchase & use your own container(s).

Apartment Recycling

- No separation required - simply commingle all recyclables
- Deposit into the blue recycling container(s) in your common refuse area—next to the dumpster(s)

Side-Load Automated Garbage Collection

Residential Container Sizes:

60 Gallon, 90 Gallon Containers

Multi-Family Residences:

300 Gallon (1-1/2 cu. yd.)
(for select units with 4 or more residences)

Using your Side-Load Can

- Don't put recyclables into your refuse can! Reduce, reuse, recycle!
- Garbage & Animal Waste must be **bagged**.
- Container closed-**do not overfill** or pack too tightly.
- **No construction material, branches, dirt, rocks, cement, etc.**
- **Ashes cooled & bagged.**
- Container placed by **7:00 a.m.** on designated pickup day.
- **Handle** towards house.
- Placed **away from** curbs, vehicles, mailboxes, trees, fences, posts, etc.
