Emergency preparedness checklist:

- Prepare ahead of time.
- Find reliable transportation to a shelter. Talk to friends, family, and neighbors to ensure a ride.
- Ensure loved ones have everything they need, including medication, sanitation, food and water.
- Plan and practice your emergency route. (At least once a month).
- Know where to seek shelter. If not in a storm shelter, seek out a friend's basement, or other secure areas.
- If you have pets put them in a kennel.
- If you can't be home, ensure someone can take care of your pet. Ask a trusted neighbor friend or family member.
- Do not allow pets to roam loose either in the shelter or after the emergency.
- All pets should have identifying tags on their collars to ensure you can be reunited with your pet if you are separated during the storm.
