## Agenda Item: Work Utility for Wastewater/Stormwater Collections Department

Staff Recommended Action: Approve bid to Ironhide Equipment in the amount of \$53,543 for a Bobcat 5600 for the Wastewater/Stormwater Collections Department

### Council Action:

### BACKGROUND:

The Stormwater and Wastewater Collections Department planned to purchase a work utility vehicle to be used for a variety of uses such as snow blowing near and around flood/sanitary pump stations and sanitary lift stations, cleaning box culverts as well as correcting deficiencies for the Flood Protection Project. The City has 46 sanitary lift/pump stations; 13 Storm Stations and 12 Flood Stations for the Wastewater/Stormwater Department.

The bids were opened on April 18, 2019 and only one bid was received from Ironhide Equipment in the amount of \$53,543.

### ANALYSIS AND FINDINGS OF FACT:

- The 2019 budget includes \$25,000 under 5200.100.5225.700.0120 Wastewater Collections – Pumping Trucks and Mounted Equipment and \$25,000 under 5400.100.5425.700.0120 Stormwater Storm Stations Trucks and Mounted Equipment
- The extra cost of \$3,543 will be funded through the Stormwater Department with a budget transfer.
