Obtaining Coverage

- ▶ Must submit a notice of intent (NOI)
 - ▶ Hybrid NOI required May 1, 2018
 - ▶ Hybrid NOI currently up on website
- ▶ Permit coverage becomes effective 7 days after a completed application is received by the department

Stormwater Permits

Stormwater runoff and snow melt can pick up chemicals, bacteria, sediment, and debris from urban areas, construction sites, and industrial facilities. Runoff that enters a storm sewer or ditch does not go to a lagoon or treatment plant. Instead, runoff flows directly to rivers, lakes, and streams without any treatment.

Stormwater permits provide a level of treatment through planning and management that minimizes pollution in runoff from urban areas, construction sites, and industrial facilities.

Construction Permits

Construction Permits: The construction general permit applies to construction projects that disturb one or more acres including smaller projects within or part of a large development.

- Develop Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) to minimize pollution from soil erosion and other sources
- 2a. Submit an electronic Notice of Intent and mail an original signed copy no later than seven days before construction starts or**
2b. Submit a Notice of Intent through the Electronic Reporting System (ERIS)
- Implement the SWPPP to minimize pollution from soil erosion and other sources like fuel, oil, and waste
- Monitor the site and complete inspections
- Submit a notice of termination once final stabilization has been met

A project is automatically covered under the permit seven days after the department receives the notice of intent.

Coverage under the permit is required for oil and gas projects if runoff from the project can carry eroded material to a water of the state. Coverage is not required for oil and gas projects if runoff will not carry eroded material to water of the state.

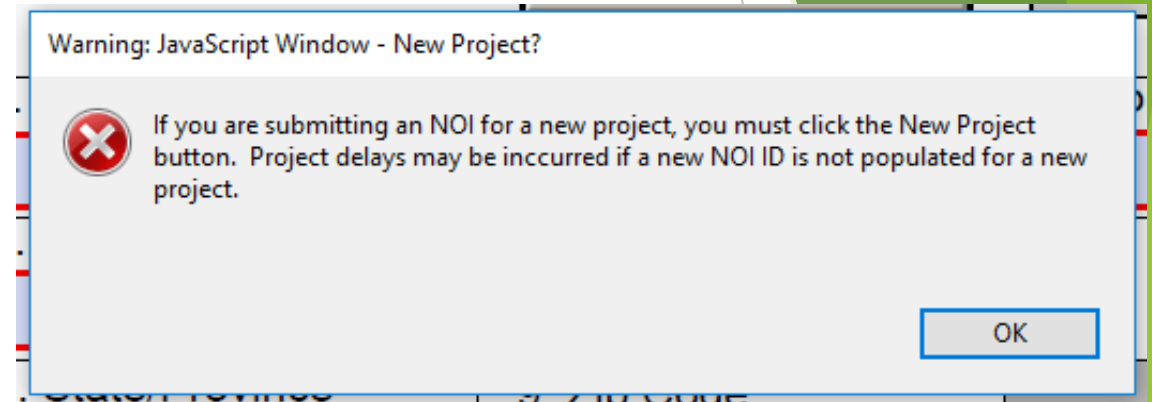

Hybrid NOI ID

- ▶ Starting Hybrid NOI
 - ▶ Download fillable PDF form from website, open up PDF
 - ▶ A pop-up warning appears regarding selecting a New Project
- ▶ Once “New Project” button is selected a new NOI ID will populate
 - ▶ The NOI ID is not the permit coverage number

Application Process

The owner, or owner jointly with the operator, shall submit a completed application containing:

- ▶ Name of owner and/or operator
- ▶ Contact information
- ▶ Project name
- ▶ Project location - latitude/longitude
- ▶ Brief description
- ▶ Start and end dates
- ▶ Size of site and area disturbance

Boxes with red outline are required fields, an error message appears when e-mailing NOI if required fields are not filled in

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Submit/Email Hybrid NOI

- ▶ Once data fields are filled out click on the “Submit by E-mail” button
- ▶ Email window will pop up and the xml document will be ready to send to stormwater@nd.gov
 - ▶ Copy and paste the NOI ID into the email subject line of your email

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Submit Hybrid NOI

- ▶ Print form
- ▶ Sign and send the NOI to the Dept. of Health
 - ▶ Signature is needed - Failure to do so is considered a violation
- ▶ Save a copy for your records
- ▶ Electronic application must be submitted first
 - ▶ Paper applications which are received prior to the electronic application being received will be returned (starting May 1, 2018)
