### **BACKGROUND:**

The intersection improvements at N Columbia Rd and 10<sup>th</sup> Ave N are proposed to include installation of left turn lanes for north bound and south bound traffic at this intersection. With the construction of UND's new medical building there has been an increased amount of northbound traffic on N Columbia Rd attempting to turn left at this intersection. Since there is currently no left turn lane here, traffic waiting to make a left turn at this location can impact through traffic.

The proposed rehabilitation project on S 42<sup>nd</sup> St between Demers Ave and Garden View Dr is anticipated to include concrete panel replacement, curb and gutter replacement, crack sealing, and other miscellaneous repairs. S 42<sup>nd</sup> St was originally constructed in 2000 using federal aid. The pavement has reached a state in which performing a minor repair project is a cost effective option to increase the life expectancy of the pavement, thus delaying the need to reconstruct the roadway.

Bids for this project were received on February 19, 2019.

The improvements at the intersection of N Columbia Rd and 10<sup>th</sup> Ave N are relatively minor and fall under the category of minor intersection improvements. It is proposed that the funding for this project come from a combination of the Street/Infrastructure Fund 4815 under the Minor Intersection Improvement and Street Maintenance line items. If the Minor Intersection Improvement and Street Maintenance is unable to fully cover the construction amount, the remainder will be paid for through Street/Infrastructure Fund 4815.

S 42<sup>nd</sup> St is a five lane roadway. In recent history the city has not special assessed roadway projects for these wider arterial streets. It is therefore proposed not to special assess this rehabilitation project and use available funding from the Street/Infrastructure Fund 4815 under the Street Maintenance line item.

City Council approved the plans and specifications at the January 22, 2019 meeting.

### **ANALYSIS AND FINDINGS OF FACT:**

- Bids were received on February 19, 2019.
- A total of 5 bids were received and opened.
- The bids received ranged from \$257,248.80 to \$379,517.86.
- The lowest bid received was from Tony Anderson Construction in the amount of \$257,248.80.
- The Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$315,143.50.
- The lowest bid received was approximately 18% below the Engineer's Estimate.
- City staff feels the low bidder is qualified to do the work of this project.
- Funding for this project will come from the Street & Infrastructure Fund 4815.


