Staff Recommended Action: Award contract to low bidder, Opp Construction, in the amount of \$287,660 for City Project No. 8015, District No. 730 – 2019 Mill and Overlay

Committee Recommended Action: Refer to City Council with the recommendation to approve.

Council Action:

BACKGROUND:

Bids for this project were received on March 18, 2019 with a low bid of \$287,660 submitted by Opp Construction. The low bid was approximately 4% over the engineers estimate of \$276,726.50.

The proposed 2019 Mill and Overlay project consists of performing a mill and asphalt overlay rehabilitation and other miscellaneous repairs on S 17th St (17th Ave S to Continental Dr) and Willow Dr using a portion of the new sales tax. S 17th St and Willow Dr were originally constructed with full depth asphalt in the 1960's and have not had a rehabilitation project since their initial construction.

This project has been considered at a number of previous Council/Committee/Public meetings, some of which are as follows:

- February 19, 2019 – Council approved the Engineer's Report, created the Special Assessment District, directed Engineering Department to prepare Plans & Specifications and advertise for Construction Bids for this project
- March 4, 2019 – Council approved the Plans and Specifications for this project
- March 14, 2019 – a public input meeting was scheduled, but cancelled due to weather
- March 26, 2019 – a rescheduled public input meeting at Red River High School

ANALYSIS AND FINDINGS OF FACT:

- Bids were received on March 18, 2019.
- A total of 4 bids were received and 4 bids were opened.
- Bids received ranged from \$287,660 to \$359,795.20.
- The lowest bid received was from Opp Construction in the amount of \$287,660.
- A portion of this project is to be funded with a City Share as current City policy is to fund the 80% cost of rehabilitation.
- City Share is to be funded from the Street & Infrastructure Fund 4815 where a total of \$2,385,000 has been budgeted in 2019 for these types of projects.
- Construction is anticipated to take place during the 2019 construction.

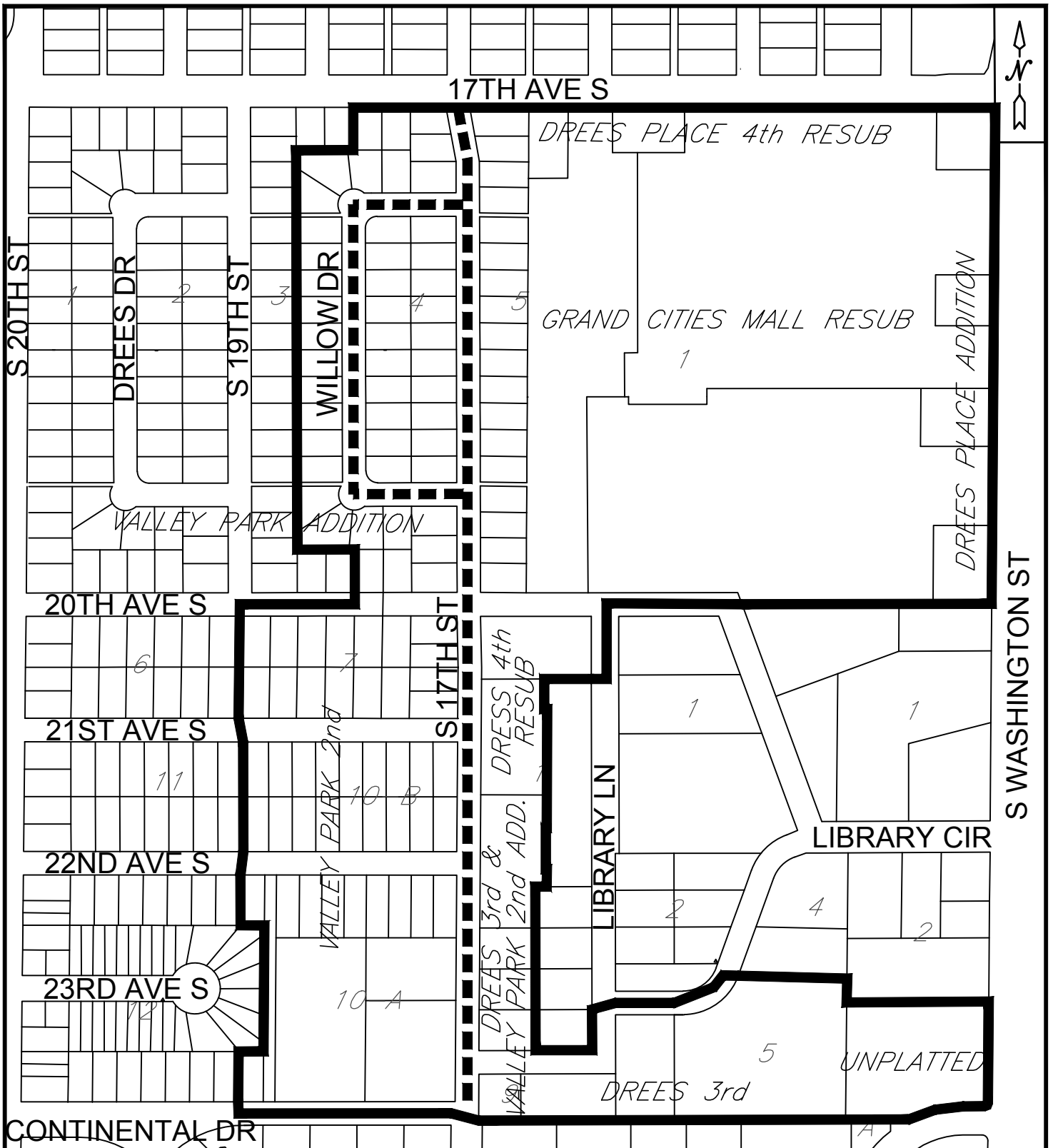
