**BACKGROUND:**

The Civil Service Commission consists of five members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. As outlined in the City Code, the Commission shall consist of one member generally associated with labor occupations; one member generally associated with management occupations; one member generally associated with the occupations or professions of personnel management, human resources, or employment regulatory compliance, having practiced within the profession for at least five years; and two members representative of the general public selected from the occupations or professions of law, banking, finance, investment, accounting, industry, commerce, labor, organized labor, education, medicine, dentistry or a recognized trade and having practiced with the profession or trade for at least five years that each serve three-year terms. The commissioners shall serve overlapping three-year terms.

**ANALYSIS AND FINDINGS OF FACT:**

- Mr. Burlog will serve as a representative of labor occupations and the term will expire April of 2022.
- Ms. Nies will serve as a representative of the general public and the term will expire May of 2022.
