

ORDINANCE NO. 4732

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TECHNICAL CODE CORRECTIONS AMENDING SECTION 21-0205 OF THE GRAND FORKS CITY CODE RELATING TO CLASSIFICATIONS OF RETAIL LICENCES: III. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS, CLASS 15.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND FORKS, NORTH DAKOTA. PURSUANT TO THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF GRAND FORKS, NORTH DAKOTA, THAT:

SECTION I. AMENDING CLAUSE

Section 21-0205 of the Grand Forks City Code relating to Class descriptions and requirements is hereby amended to provide as follows:

21-0205. - Same-Classifications.

The following classes of retail licenses are hereby established:

....

III. Class descriptions and requirements:


....

Class 15. Winery on-sale and off-sale license. The Grand Forks City Council may issue an unlimited number of domestic winery licenses to operate a domestic winery and to sell wine "on-sale" and "off-sale," subject to the following restrictions and conditions:

- (1) Such license may be issued only to a domestic winery owner or operator holding a license from the state tax commissioner allowing for the production of wine.
- (2) Any license issued hereunder will only authorize the licensee to sell wine produced on the premises by the licensee at "on-sale" or "off-sale, in retail lots, and not for resale, in total quantities not in excess of ten thousand (10,000) gallons in a calendar year.
- (3) A licensee under this section shall be authorized to sell glassware, wine literature, and accessories, cheese, cheese spreads, and other snack food items in addition to the sale of wine.
- (4) A licensee under this section may apply for a Class 11 special or limited license as provided in this article.
- (5) A winery licensee may offer complimentary samples of wine produced on the premises provided that the size of each sample is no greater than two (2) fluid ounces and that the total of all samples not exceed eight (8) fluid ounces per customer.


SECTION II. EFFECTIVE DATE.

BACKGROUND:

Grand Forks City Code Section 21-0205(III) (Class 15) (2) contains an error. The word “sell” is omitted. This Ordinance makes a technical correction to add the word “sell”.

ANALYSIS AND FINDINGS OF FACT:

Current requirements of a Class 15 winery on-sale and off-sale license has an error in the omission of the word “sell”. This Ordinance corrects the error.
