The Nest on Fourth **Background**

- Social Detox opened in 2017
 - Operated by Grand Forks Public Health
 - 8 bed facility, licensed by ND DHHS
 - Average census was 2 people per night
- Need for low-barrier emergency shelter
 - Adult individuals unable to access resources
- Transition in 2024
 - Community collaboration
 - City, County, State, Altru support





The Nest on Fourth **Today**

- Opened October 2nd, 2024
 - Administered by Grand Forks Housing Authority
 - Partnership with Grand Forks Homes, Inc.
- Operations
 - 1 Program Coordinator
 - 4 Full Time, 10 Part Time
 - Referrals from Community Partners

The Nest on Fourth **Data (as of 5/31/25)**

- Number of people served = 134
 - Men 116, Women 18
 - Age 18 - 24 = 6
 - Age 25 - 34 = 36
 - Age 35 - 44 = 39
 - Age 45 - 54 = 26
 - Age 55 - 64 = 21
 - Age 65+ = 5



The Nest on Fourth **Data (continued)**

- Residency question began 12/12/2024
 - From Grand Forks 58
 - From North Dakota 4
 - From Out of State 9
- Snapshot of residency today
 - From Grand Forks 11
 - From North Dakota 1
 - From Out of State 4
- Average length of stay is 28 days
