Mr. Gador, Mechanical Board President called the meeting to order at 4:08 PM

1. Appointment of Mechanical Board Chair

Mr. Gador opened the floor for discussion of Mechanical Board Chair. After discussion, Mr. Gador said he would be willing to continue in this role until his term ends in 2026 at which time a new president would need to be named.

2. Approve meeting minutes of September 29th, 2022

3. Update on Statewide Mechanical Testing

David Slominski gave an update on statewide mechanical testing. Adopting the 2024 International Codes and modifying the tests to stay in line with the changes. He informed the board that along with Grand Forks, Fargo, Minot, and Bismarck that currently administer the test, Dickinson and Williston will start testing in their jurisdictions as well. Grand Forks, Fargo, & Minto are still the main creators of the tests.

4. Review of Proposed 2024 International Mechanical & Fuel Gas Code State Amendments.

Mechanical board reviewed amendments state is adopting. Will incorporate approved amendments into city adopted code.

5. Review current amendments of the 2021 International Mechanical and International Fuel Gas Codes

Mechanical Board reviewed current amendments of the 2021 International Codes and changes within the 2024 International Mechanical Code and International Fuel Gas Codes. Incorporated changes they thought best suited the city and its jurisdictional area.
